Hong Kong International Computer Conference 2010 Held Today
Starting Up a New Wave of Initiatives for a Caring and Digitally Connected Society

Hong Kong – 28 September, 2010 – Focusing on the theme of “IT Challenges in a Caring and Digitally Connected Society”, Hong Kong International Computer Conference (HKICC) 2010 was opened officially today by The Honourable Mrs. Rita Lau Ng Wai-lan, JP, Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development, The Government of the HKSAR, Mr. Jeremy Godfrey, HKICC2010 Organising Committee Chairperson and Government Chief Information Officer of the HKSAR Government, Ir. Stephen Lau Ka-man, JP, President of the Hong Kong Computer Society and Dr. Cheung Nim-kwan, HKICC2010 Programme Committee Chairperson and CEO of The Hong Kong Applied Science and Technology Research Institute (ASTRI). Coinciding with the Community’s Dress Special Day, the international information technology conference called for joint efforts to sculpture a digitally connected society that is caring and sustaining. HKICC2010 is hosted at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre on 28-29 September 2010.

Hong Kong has seen a series of initiatives to propel progress in society and to help those in need. This is in line with HKICC2010’s call for swift action to narrow the digital gap and possible marginalisation of parts of the population, especially the aged and the underprivileged. The ongoing support from the Digital Cyber Centre Alliance, the launch of eElderly to facilitate a user-friendly internet platform for the elderly leveraging an online platform to elicit innovation and creativity to make Hong Kong a better place to live, is a perfect example of the community’s effort to apply information technology positively and narrow the digital divide Hong Kong is facing.
