HKICT Awards: Smart Business Award

Background

- The **Hong Kong ICT Awards** aims at :
 - recognising and promoting outstanding information and communications technology (ICT) inventions and applications, thereby encouraging innovation and excellence among Hong Kong's ICT talent and enterprises in their constant pursuit of creative and better solutions to meet business and social needs.
- **HKICT Awards was established in 2006** with the collaborative efforts of the industry, academia and the Government.
- Organised by the Digital Policy Office (DPO), the HKICTA 2026 has **eight award categories** led by eight selected local industry associations and professional bodies.

Background

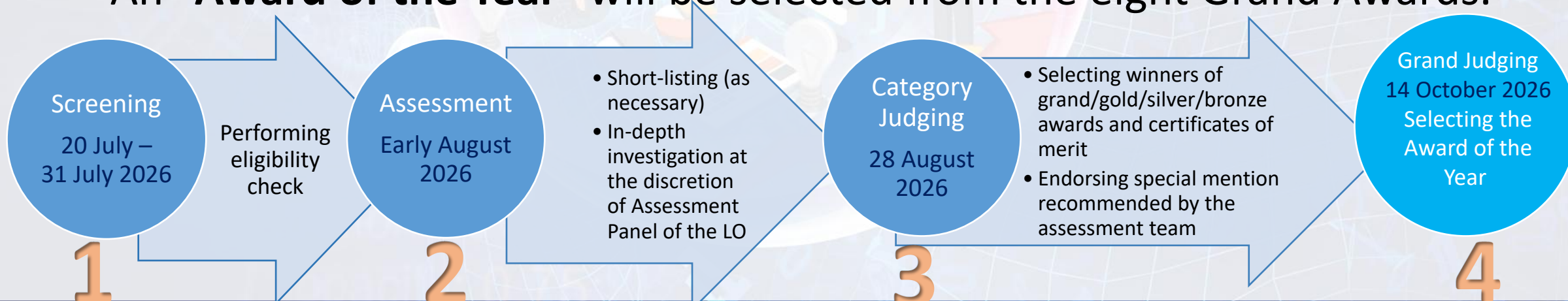
- Since 2006, **HKCS** has been appointed as one of the Leading Organisers.
- This year, HKCS continues to undertake the “**Smart Business Award**” that covers **3 streams**, including:
 - ***Emerging Technologies***
 - ***Solution for Business and Public Sector Enterprise***
 - ***Solution for SME***

Background

- In addition, a bid to foster the innovative use of artificial intelligence (AI), **each** of the eight categories has established a **distinguished accolade**: the "**Best Use of AI**" award since last year, magnifying and honouring outstanding achievements in harnessing the power of AI in respective areas.

Adjudication Process

- The winners will be selected as **Grand/Gold/Silver/Bronze Awards** and Certificates of Merit.
- There will be **one** Grand Award in each category
- There will be **one** “Best Use of AI” Award in each category
- An "**Award of the Year**" will be selected from the eight Grand Awards.



Adjudication Format

- For face-to-face presentation, only have
 - **10-minute**
 - **Plus 10-minute Q&A**
- Language for presentation chosen in the application form, select one of following options
 - **English**
 - **Cantonese**
 - **Mandarin**

Be the winners....

- The remarkable achievements of the Awards winners will be recognised by customers, organisations, the ICT industry practitioners and across the community.

Winners will be entitled :

- to receive trophies (Gold/Silver/Bronze) of the HKICTA;
- to display the official logo of the HKICTA in their promotional materials;
- to participate in various promotional campaigns to publicise their achievements;
- to be supported for entering into other regional and international awards and competitions;
- to 3 months free access to co-working space in Hong Kong Science Park Incubation Centre for eligible SMEs¹;

¹ Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks Corporation (HKSTP) offers one quota to a 3-month rent free access in co-working space in Hong Kong Science Park Incubation Centre (assigned by HKSTP, subject to availability) to the eligible SMEs who are Hong Kong ICT Awards 2026 Gold, Silver or Bronze award winners.



Winners will be entitled :

- to participate in investment matching activities co-organised by the Hong Kong Venture Investment and Business Angel Network Limited (HKBAN) and Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks Corporation (HKSTP);
- to 3 months free access to Flexi Space in Cyberport Entrepreneurship Centre for SMEs² and
- to free participation in some large-scale local ICT events (e.g. InnoEX) for marketing exposure;
- to be invited to join the“ HKICTA Winner Circle.

²Cyberport offers 1 free Flexi Space in Cyberport Entrepreneurship Centre (5/F, Core F, Cyberport 3) for 3 months to SMEs who are HKICTA 2026 Gold, Silver or Bronze award winners. The number of flexi-desk offered to the Winners is capped to 32. Given the quota, flexi-desk will be offered on a first-come-first-served basis and subject to the availability. Winner shall submit application to Cyberport for the offered flexi-desk on or before 31 March 2027 after the announcement of results. Any submission after the deadline will become ineligible.

General Eligibility Requirements

- **IP Ownership** – The applicant must have **the intellectual property right and/or legitimate right** over the ICT product/service mentioned in the application. The applicant shall disclose disputes any place over the world over intellectual property right about the applicant's ICT product/service, if any, for the Leading Organiser to consider eligibility of the application.
- **A Hong Kong Entity** – The application must be submitted **by locally (Hong Kong) registered entities (please enclose Company/Business Registration proof) or residents in Hong Kong⁴** at the time of closing for entry enrolment.
- **Indigenous Development** – **A significant part** of the innovation, design, research and development (R&D) of the mentioned ICT product/service **must come from resources in Hong Kong**. The applicant should demonstrate **significant value-add by the Hong Kong resources** contributing to the success of the ICT product/service in the target market.

⁴ "Residents in Hong Kong", in the context of HKICT Awards, include both permanent and non-permanent residents. If an entry is submitted by more than one person, at least half of the members of the group must be Hong Kong resident. For the case of Student Innovation category, certification of Hong Kong resident status can be performed through certifying student status collectively by concerned educational institution.

General Eligibility Requirements

- **Market Ready** – With the exception of the Student Innovation category, the submitted **product/service must have been available⁵ in the market for at least 3 months or in live operation for at least 3 months** at the time of closing for entry enrolment (please enclose proof – e.g. delivery note, invoice, public announcement, advertisement, internal announcement, etc.).
- **Single Submission** – The same application is only allowed to be submitted to a **maximum of ONE award stream** among all the Categories. Any application found to have entered into more than one award stream will be disqualified.
- **Previous Winning Entries** – **Winning entries** of the Gold/Silver/Bronze award in **previous years** of the HKICT Awards can enter the Awards again only if there is **significant change or enhancement in the product/service, or for a new award category**.

⁵Examples are applications and products already in the market, application systems deployed internally in a company, and mobile solutions available at App Stores. For startup companies competing for ICT Startup Award, prototypes appear only on kickstarter or similar platforms are NOT considered as available in the market.

General Pointers

STUDY

UNDERSTAND

ADDRESS

the Judging Criteria

A GOOD PRESENTATION FLOW

- What is the problem?
- What are you trying to solve?
- The Solution
- The differentiating features (speed, uniqueness, etc.)
- The benefits
- The accolade/awards/patents

General Pointers

- Bring out the **Unique** and **Differentiating** features of your product /application. (fore runner, nobody has done this before, size of captured and potential markets, number of customers, global reach, huge benefits achieved and quantifiable), particularly comparing to competitors/peer organisations.
- PATENTS?

General Pointers

Remember this is a
Technology Award

So you have to talk about technology!

General Pointers

- External accolade (awards, quotations from surveys and magazines, top ranking in the world/region, customers' appreciation, newspaper, magazines, etc.) these are much more powerful than your own "claim". In fact, they add more value to your "claims".

Don't Be Shy!

General Pointers

- Ideally a presentation team of two persons (1 as the main presenter, good presentation and marketing skills, understand the product/application; the other is the technical guy to answer technical questions), but fine to have a single presenter who has both attributes.
- **Be confident, but not arrogant.**

General Pointers

Q & A Session

- Give equal weighting in preparation to presentation (key to being granted an award!)
- Understand what is being asked, if not ask for the question to be repeated
- If you don't know the answer, do not bullshit!
- To supplement good points you have missed or insufficient time to make during your presentation
- Do MOCK Presentation session with Q&A !

Preparing for the Presentation

- Rehearse, rehearse, rehearse!!
- Mindful of allotted time/duration!
- Have a good night sleep the night before, and no exotic food!
- Get to the venue early (do you absolutely know where it is?)
