Hong Kong Computer Society Integrates its Digital Membership Card into “iAM Smart”

Pioneering eGovernment Application for All Members and
marking an industry-first initiative among Hong Kong’s IT professional organisations

August 16, 2026 Hong Kong - The Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS) has become the first information technology professional organisation in Hong Kong to integrate its membership card into the “iAM Smart”. Effective immediately, all HKCS members are able to add their digital membership cards to the Digital Document under the Personal Assistant page of the “iAM Smart” mobile application.

Going forward, HKCS members attending events organised by the Society or industry partners, as well as enjoying member benefits, can simply present their digital membership cards through the “iAM Smart” mobile application, eliminating the need to carry physical cards and offering a more convenient experience.

Mr. Dave Chen, President of HKCS stated:

“The Hong Kong Computer Society has long been committed to promoting digital innovation within the industry and actively supporting the Government’s Smart City initiatives, including the expansion of e-Government services to benefit a larger demographic. By having our membership card in the “iAM Smart” digital document, we hope to encourage members to experience and support the development of Hong Kong’s e-Government systems firsthand, while delivering a more convenient service experience.”
