Hong Kong Computer Society Elected New Council Members

Continue to Strive for Council Development through its Commitment to Professional Development, Young IT Talent Cultivation and Society Caring Through ICT as Priorities

June 3, 2024, Hong Kong – The new Council members of the Hong Kong Computer Society (HKCS), the well recognised Information and Communication Technology (ICT) professional body in Hong Kong, have been elected in the Annual General Meeting on 22 May 2024. To lead HKCS to a new milestone, Dr. Rocky Cheng, President of HKCS and Council members will continue to its commitment to professional and industry development as well as community services with three main goals, namely talent cultivation and professional development; industry development and collaboration, and the effective use of IT in our community. These commitments aim to foster the further development of HKCS, and assist the Hong Kong ICT industry to enhance its competitiveness in the international arena, and thus contribute to the long-term development of the Hong Kong economy.

Dr. Rocky Cheng, President of the HKCS said: “Last year marked a significant return to the international stage for Hong Kong, a year of advancing to prosperity and the telling of the good stories of Hong Kong. Similarly, for HKCS, it has been a challenging yet fruitful year. Our five Specialist Groups – Artificial Intelligence, Financial Technology, Cyber Security, Enterprise Architecture and Innovation and Entrepreneurship have continued to engage our members and the public by organising a series of offline and online events including Webinars, Luncheons, Workshops and Forums in order to build a stronger tie with our members, effectively reflect the interests of them and evolving trends in the IT industry. Professional and industry experts were invited to share their insights and knowledge with our members.”

Dr. Cheng pointed out that HKCS, for supporting technology policies and participating in social affairs, has been putting forward professional suggestions for the future development of IT, and publicises opinions on important technology issues in response to the Budget and Policy Address each year. So far, HKCS was pleased to see many of its recommendations being adopted by the Government. Looking to the future, HKCS will continue to actively play the role of "I&T Think Tank", providing advices to the Government, strengthening the role in promoting continuous professional development in the industry, enhancing the professional level of the

industry, cultivating young talent, and strengthening its cooperation with industry partners and government agencies.

Dr. Cheng further: “During the year, HKCS has achieved fruitful results in promoting Hong Kong as an international centre for innovation and technology and telling good stories of Hong Kong technology. HKCS was appointed again by the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer (OGCIO) as the Leading Organiser of ‘The Hong Kong ICT Awards 2023: Smart Business Award’, with the appointment reaching its 17th consecutive year. And with the support of the OGCIO, HKCS successfully co-organised the ‘Asia Pacific Information and Communications Technology Alliance Awards 2023’ (APICTA 2023) in December 2023 with OGCIO. This event was held in Hong Kong for the third time after 2004 and 2013. Nominated by HKCS, Hong Kong representatives, with their outstanding contributions in different sectors of the industry, won 20 awards in total, with 7 Winner and 13 Merit Awards. Hong Kong has consistently been the economy with the most winner awards in recent years, reaffirming the city's position at the forefront of IT development in the Asia Pacific region and solidifying its status as an international I&T centre.’

Dr. Cheng furthered: “In the future, the HKCS will continue to devote more efforts toward talent cultivation, such as introducing more recognised international professional certifications to promote the professional development of the industry, and providing I&T people a better understanding of the industry’s prospects. HKCS will also try to attract more young people to join the I&T industry, for example, by encouraging more uptake of IT courses and cultivating soft power for their personal development. At the same time, HKCS will also urge the government to provide young people in Hong Kong with a good ecology for employment and entrepreneurship, so as to help them realise the dream of changing the world with technology and creating a better future. Besides, HKCS will assist members in tapping more development opportunities in Greater Bay Area by strengthening communications with its cooperation partners in the Area.”

Dr. Cheng remarked: "On behalf of the HKCS, I would like to thank the members of the previous Council as well as all Committees for their support and contributions. We also welcome the new members to this session. Their joining brings the Council with an even broader spectrum of industry’s distinguished talents, which enables us to strive for the development of the ICT industry in Hong Kong. In addition to professional development and talent cultivation, HKCS will also step into the community in the future to promote caring for the society through ICT. We hope to

consolidate wider efforts of our industry, in order to encourage and assist the community in enhancing the digital operations, through our profound technology expertise and experience.”
